N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission Meeting

Approval of June 6th, 2024 Meeting Minutes – The Commission approved the June 6, 2024, Wildlife Resources Commission meeting minutes as written in the exhibit. **(EXHIBIT A)**

Motion from the Small Game & Wild Turkey Committee – The Commission approved a motion to adopt a new Wildlife Turkey Management Goal: To provide quality spring gobbler hunting opportunities by conserving North Carolina’s wild turkeys.

Phase II Land Acquisition – The Commission approved the acquisition of Greens Thoroughfare – Craven County **(EXHIBIT C)**

Final Adoption – 15A NCAC 10F .0321 Pender County Town of Surf City – The Commission reviewed public comments presented in **(EXHIBIT D-1)** and approved amendments to create two no wake zones along the Surf City waterfront in parts of Topsail Sound and Topsail Creek, north and south of the Intracoastal Waterway from east of the N.C. Highway 210 Surf City Bridge, and to incorporate into the NC Administrative Code (NCAC) four boating access areas (BAA’s) in Pender County presented in **(EXHIBIT D-2)**

Permanent Rulemaking Applications – 15A NCAC 10F .0305 Brunswick County and Town of Sunset Beach; Adopt Fiscal Note for Two Locations in Town of Sunset Beach – The Commission denied the application for rulemaking by the Town of Sunset Beach for a no-wake zone in part of South Jinks Creek presented in **(EXHIBIT E-1)**, denied of the application for rulemaking by the Town of Sunset Beach for a no-wake zone in a portion of Fox Creek between 28th and 40th Street presented in **(EXHIBIT E-2)**, denied the Fiscal Note for the Town of Sunset Beach at South Jinks Creek and Fox Creek presented in **(EXHIBIT E-3)**, and approved technical corrections to the Brunswick County Rule 15A NCAC 10F .0305 presented in **(EXHIBIT E-4)**

Permanent Rulemaking Applications – 15A NCAC 10F .0330 Carteret County – The Commission denied of the application from Carteret County for rulemaking to create a no-wake zone at Raymond’s Gut in Peletier presented in **(EXHIBIT F-1)** and approved publishing Notice of Text in the *NC Register* with an open comment period and public hearing to incorporate ten Carteret County Boating Access Areas into the NCAC presented in **(EXHIBIT F-2)**

Notice of Text – 15A NCAC 10F .0332 Alexander County – The Commission approved publishing Notice of Text in the *NC Register* with an open comment period and a public hearing for a restricted area at the request of Duke Energy LLC, at Wittenburg Access Area on Lake Hickory in Bethlehem in Alexander County presented in **(EXHIBIT G-1)**; and approved publishing Notice of Text in the *NC Register* with an open comment period and a public hearing to extend the no-wake zone on Lake Hickory in Taylorsville in Alexander County, beginning at the Rink Dam and extending southeast ending within 50 yards of the new docks at the Sand Bar Marina and Grill; and to incorporate into the NCAC the Dusty Ridge Boating Access Area in Taylorsville and Wittenburg Boating Access Area in Bethlehem presented in **(EXHIBIT G-2)**

Permanent Rulemaking Applications – 15A NCAC 10F .0333 Lake Wylie Marine Commission – The Commission approved the application from the Lake Wylie Marine Commission 15A NCAC 10F .0333 to publish Notice of Text in the *NC Register* with open comment period and public hearing to create a no-wake zone within 50 yards of Joyner’s Marina adjacent to the no-wake zone east of Buster Boyd Bridge presented in **(EXHIBIT H-1)**; denied the application from the Lake Wylie Marine Commission to extend the no-wake zone around the west side of Sadler Island in Mecklenburg and Gaston counties presented in **(EXHIBIT H-2)**; denied the application from Lake Wylie Marine Commission for a no-wake zone in the waters north and east of Sunset Island presented in **(EXHIBIT H-3)**; and approved publishing Notice of Text in the *NC Register* with open comment period and public hearing for technical corrections to the Rule to replace the South Carolina coordinate for the eastern side of the Buster Boyd Bridge no-wake zone with a point in North Carolina; and to strike from the NCAC 10F .0333(a)(13) Other Facilities and 10F .0333(a)(14) Marked Swimming and Mooring areas presented in **(EXHIBIT H-4)**
