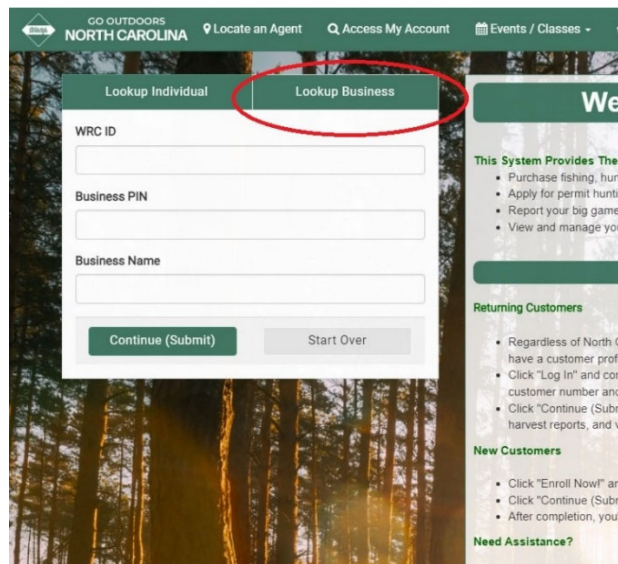


Online Application Instructions for DMAP Programs (ver. 2026)

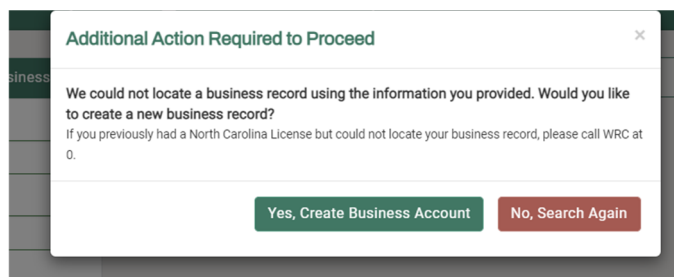
The DMAP program includes 4 types of management assistance: 1) traditional Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP), 2) Community Deer Management Assistance Program (CDMAP), 3) Chronic Wasting Disease Management Assistance Program (CWDMAP), and 4) Agricultural Deer Management Assistance Program (AgDMAP). The DMAP programs are designed for entities which include, but are not limited to: hunt clubs, farming businesses, homeowner/property associations, large property owners, and corporations (see program overview document for further information and requirements).

To apply for any of the Deer Management Assistance Programs, customers will use their online Go Outdoors North Carolina account (GoOutdoorsNorthCarolina.com). This online system will allow customers to submit applications, track approval processes, print final documents, and view reported harvests for their permit. DMAP applications are not accessible via the Go Outdoors North Carolina mobile app. Applications will be reviewed by a district biologist before final permit approval. The district biologist will determine valid season dates, tag allocations, and potential weapon restrictions on the final permit. Applications are accessible through “Business” accounts only, not “Individual” accounts. If you do not have an existing business account, you can create one using the instructions below. **If you experience difficulties using the online system, you may call our wildlife management office for assistance at 919-707-0058 during normal business hours.**

To apply, customers must login to GoOutdoorNorthCarolina.com using their Business account (“Lookup Business” tab). To create a “business” account, first enter and search for the name of the business. When no results are found, select “Yes, Create Business Account.”)

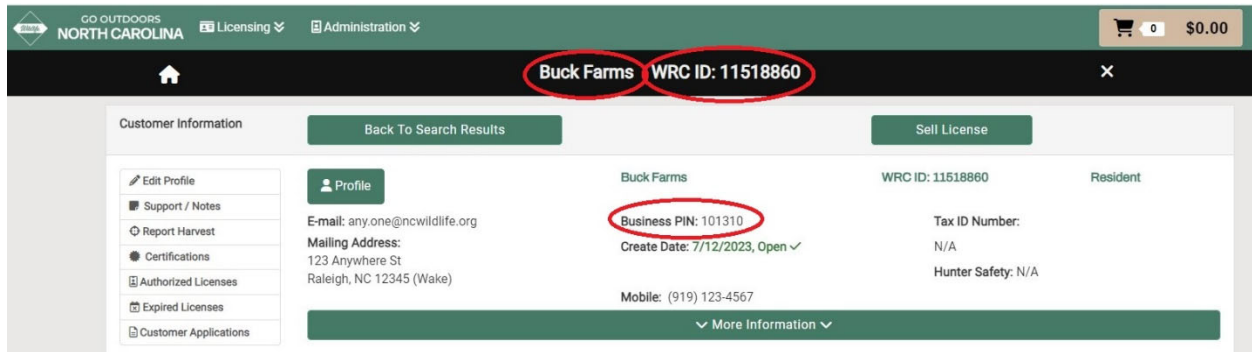

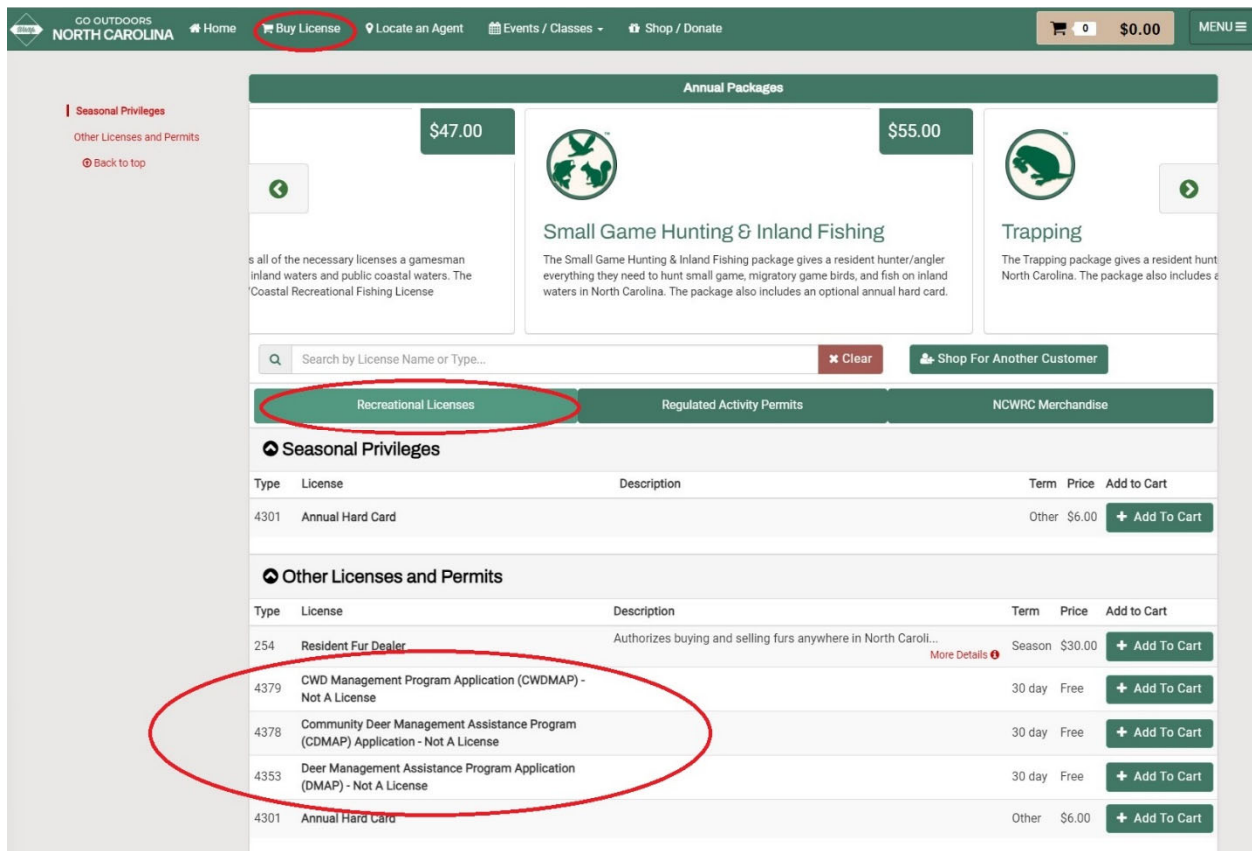

Once created for the first time, the user will be issued a WRC ID#, Business PIN, and Business Name. Please retain these login credentials for future use. These identification numbers are similar to your hunting license number and will be the same for your business entity for all future GoOutdoors transactions. Your business name could be the name of your hunt club or the name of your farm. Please note that your "Business Name" must be spelled exactly the same with every login, otherwise you will not be able to access your business account. These credentials will also be printed on your final approved permit and/or cover letter.



To locate the DMAP application after you have created your account, go to 'Buy License' > 'Recreational Licenses' tab > 'Other Licenses and Permits' section and select the appropriate type of DMAP application (DMAP, CDMAP, CWDMAP, or AgDMAP) - **please only choose one**. Your selection will be added to your shopping cart.



During the 'Checkout' process, you will be asked to complete a series of questions. When complete, press 'Submit' at the bottom of the page.

There will be no charge for submitting a DMAP application. When your transaction is complete, press "Checkout Now." If you have a valid email address, you will receive confirmation that the application has been received and has gone into 'Pending' status.

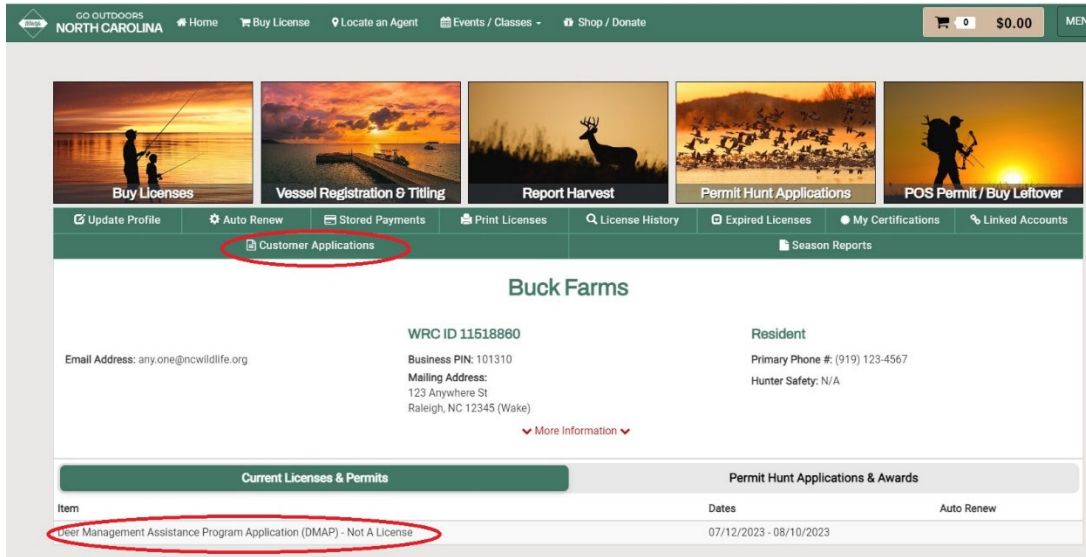

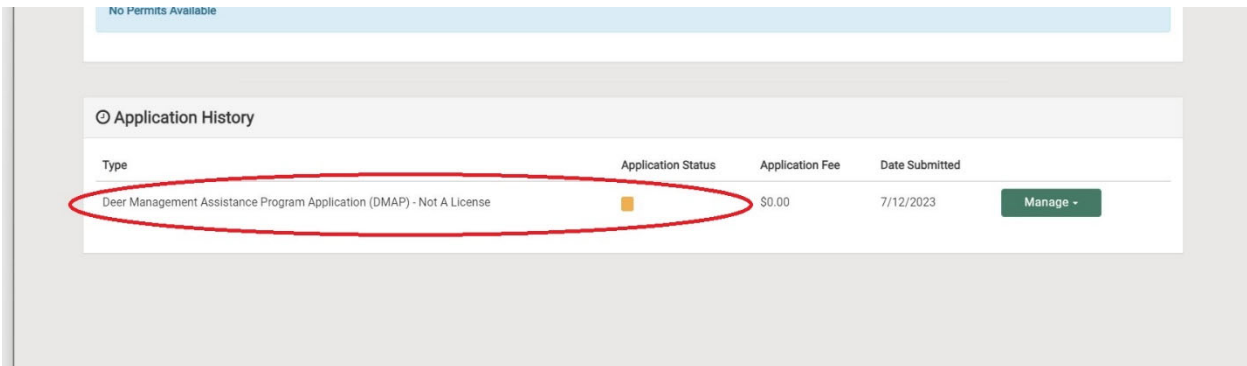

Your application will go into 'Pending' status during this time and display under your "Current Licenses & Permits" for 30 days. During this time, you may check on the status of your application by clicking on

“Customer Applications” tab located on the Home page. Prior to application approval, you may be contacted by a district biologist to review your application request.



Scroll to the bottom of the “Customer Application” screen to find the “Application History” section. A yellow block will appear under ‘Application Status’ when the application is ‘Pending.’ A green block will appear when the application has been ‘Approved.’ You will receive another confirmation email when final approval is given.



DMAP packages will be mailed after August. Please make sure the mailing address listed on your business account is correct and you can receive mail at the address. DMAP packages include your tagging/reporting instructions and associated deer tags.
